- **Nursery** - All the parents/carers of the 2 year old room are welcome to come into the class at the start of each session, 8:45 to 9:00 morning session and 12.30 to 12:45 afternoon session with their child to help them find their name and explore the activities on offer. The Book Library is open every Tuesday and Friday (8.45am for morning children and 12.30pm for afternoon children) for parents to choose a book to read with their child.
- **Holidays during Term time** - In line with National Guidance, Heybrook Primary School and Nursery does **NOT** allow holidays in term time. There are **190** statutory school days in one school year; this leaves **175** days every year available for holidays. Children should attend nursery everyday unless they are ill. The law *does not allow the school* to grant permission for parents to take their children away from education for a holiday. Any children who are missing from nursery may be taken off the register if their attendance drops below 80% and may not be able to return. If your child is age 5 or above, unauthorised leave for 10 sessions (5 school days) or more will qualify for a fine. No warning will be issued from the Local Authority.
- **Dinner monies** must be paid every Monday. The cost for the week is £10.50 and envelopes are provided by the teacher.
- **Library fines amnesty** - Throughout February, Rochdale Borough Libraries are holding a library fines and overdue books amnesty. Any customers with lost or overdue books are encouraged to call in to their local library and speak to a member of staff. All charges will be waived and, if necessary, a replacement membership card issued, so that returning customers can enjoy access to books, computers, e-books & e-audiobooks, wi-fi, events & activities for all the family, and much, much more.
- **School Uniform** We would like to remind parents that trainers must not be worn for school. The uniform policy states that black school shoes must be worn.
- **Breakfast Club** is open every morning at 8.15 am. Children can enjoy fun activities and a breakfast of toast or cereal for 50p per day.
