

Sports Premium Funding 2017-18

The government provides additional funding to improve the provision of Physical Education (PE) and Sport within primary schools. The details of the grants and the manner in which Heybrook uses the allocation can be found below.

For the financial year Heybrook is expected to receive 2017/18, £16,666 has been allocated based on 597 pupils (Reception – Year 6). This will be confirmed in April 2018.

Sports Competitions £500	Provide pupils with opportunities to compete against other schools, locally (e.g. against other schools within the IPLCN) and further afield (e.g. national competitions run by Rochdale AFC). To take place throughout the year. Before / After School Clubs £3200	Provide staff to run after school club sessions that afford pupils opportunities to develop skills in different areas such as Football, Karate (professionally coached), Badminton (professionally coached) and Multi-sports. To take place throughout the year.	
Karate Coaching Karate - £5840	Provide all pupils within EYFS (Reception) and Key Stage One with the opportunity to access karate coaching from professionals with whom we have existing relationships. These sessions encourage pupils to develop discipline, spatial awareness and coordination. To take place throughout the year.
